 - 3. Unofficial copy of your college transcripts (CU Succeeds, CSU, AIMS, FRCC, etc.)
 - 4. Unofficial copy of your PSD transcript
 - 5. Copy of AP scores that were received directly from College Board (required only if you're using any AP scores for ASCENT eligibility)
